



Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) is a multidisciplinary teaching strategy that takes on the task of delivering assertive outreach, acute, active, and continuous community-based psychiatric treatment, as well as rehabilitation and support. The team offers individualized support to promote healing while inspiring optimism and a sense of power. Individuals might gain respect and value in their communities as a result.

The psychosocial services offered by the ACT program are primarily geared toward individuals who have severe and persistent mental illness. This frequently involves individuals who deal with multiple issues at once, such as substance use, homelessness, or involvement with the legal system.

Assertive Community Treatment is a successful approach for delivering community-based services to individuals whose needs and goals have not been satisfied by conventional office-based treatment and rehabilitation programs.
