Our IDD team of committed and skilled specialists helps people, and their families develop life skills and selfadvocacy while boosting self-esteem, confidence, and independence via a caring, person-centered approach. We collaborate to improve people's everyday activities and quality of life via physical activity, education, arts & crafts, and leisure activities.

Services Offered:

- Community Access A program that is focused on community integration. These services are designed to help the individuals develop skills to be independent and comfortable while they navigate community services
- Pre-Vocational Services Prevocational services prepare an individual for employment by teaching social skills, communication skills, problem solving, safety and other work-related skills.
- Supported Employment Supported Employment helps individuals obtain competitive work in the community and provide the supports necessary to ensure their success in the workplace.
- Community Living Arrangement Community Living Arrangement (CLA) is a one-on-one 24/7 home supervision. Services include providing financial, healthcare, medication and behavioral management through a team of Human Service Technician, Developmental Disability professionals, and a Licensed Behavioral Health Analyst. Staff provides transportation and oversight of the individual into the community for shopping, dining, and various events for the purpose of community integration.
- Nursing Services RN oversight on medication management and nursing assessments annually and when there is a change in medical status.
- Routine Medical/Dental Services Staff advocacy to ensure that all individuals have access to annual medical and dental services.
